THE SPEAKER: MATT JOHNSON

Shaped by the influence of his missionary parents, Matt's journey has taken him across the Philippines, Malta, and North America. His call to full-time ministry came in an unexpected moment at a youth camp, when the only person available to pray

with him was the rented bus driver. That calling has led to more than two decades of serving as a youth pastor in two countries, connecting with multiple ministry networks, and now stepping into the role of a church planter—though deep down, he still feels like a youth pastor at heart. Together with his wife Kat, Matt is passionate about discipling and empowering the next generation, believing that Jesus is the greatest person anyone will ever meet. Kat is not only his partner in ministry but also the one who can do everything he can... and everything he can't (how is she so good at everything?). Their daughters, Penny and Lucy, still laugh at his jokes, though these days, they're just as likely to be laughing at him.
